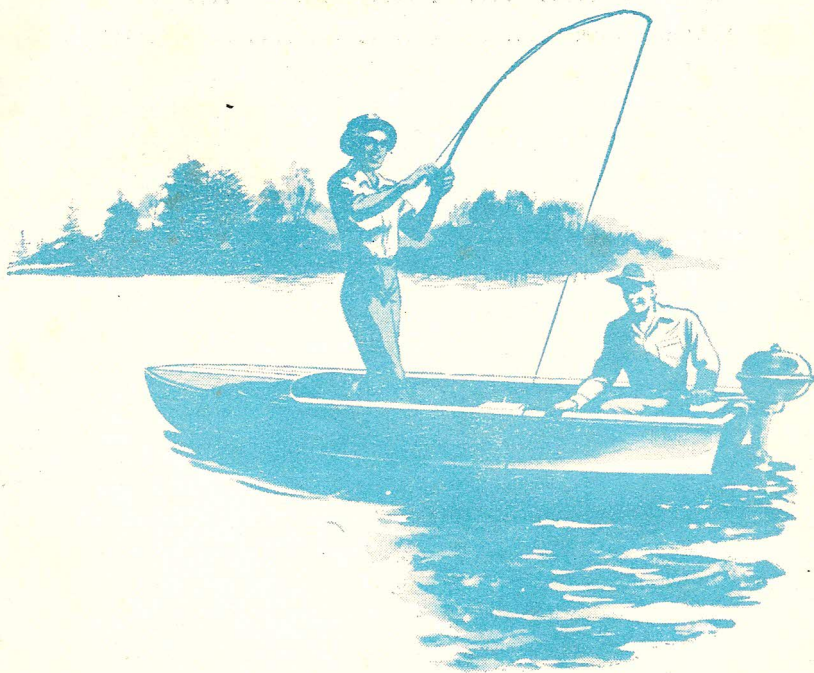

SUMMARY OF ANGLING REGULATIONS OF NEWFOUNDLAND

<u>Kind of Fish</u>	<u>Open Season</u>	<u>Limit of Catch</u>
Salmon	May 15th to Sept. 15th	8 in one day
<u>Fly fishing only permitted on Scheduled Rivers.</u>		
Sea Trout	May 15th to Sept. 15th	24 in one day
	Except Fox Island and Serpentine Rivers where catch is limited to 8 only in one day.	
Note:-No person shall have in his possession at any time more than seventy two (72) trout taken in inland waters.		
Rainbow Trout	June 1st to Nov. 30th	36 in one day
Trout other than sea or rainbow trout	January 15th to Sept. 15th	36 in one day
