- Tackle suggestions — Rod, 5 to 8 oz.,
9½ ft., reel holding fly casting line
with 100 yards of backing (minimum).
- Flies — any of the following will take
fish: Jock Scott, Black Dose, Black
Doctor, Silver Doctor, Thunder and
Lightning, Blue Charm, — sizes 4 to
12; 1 - 2 for flooded river. Dry Flies,
6 and 8 mostly used; a few 12s; 14s
recommended for low river. Bivisibles,
Pink Lady, White and Gray Wulffs are
types of dry fly used.
- Guides — courteous and expert.
- Rates — At Afton Farm House, \$13.00
per day, which includes Board, Room,
and Guide.
- Salmon Fishing Season —
MAY 15 TO SEPTEMBER 15
- Licenses obtainable at Port aux Basques
or from Wardens at Tompkins.
