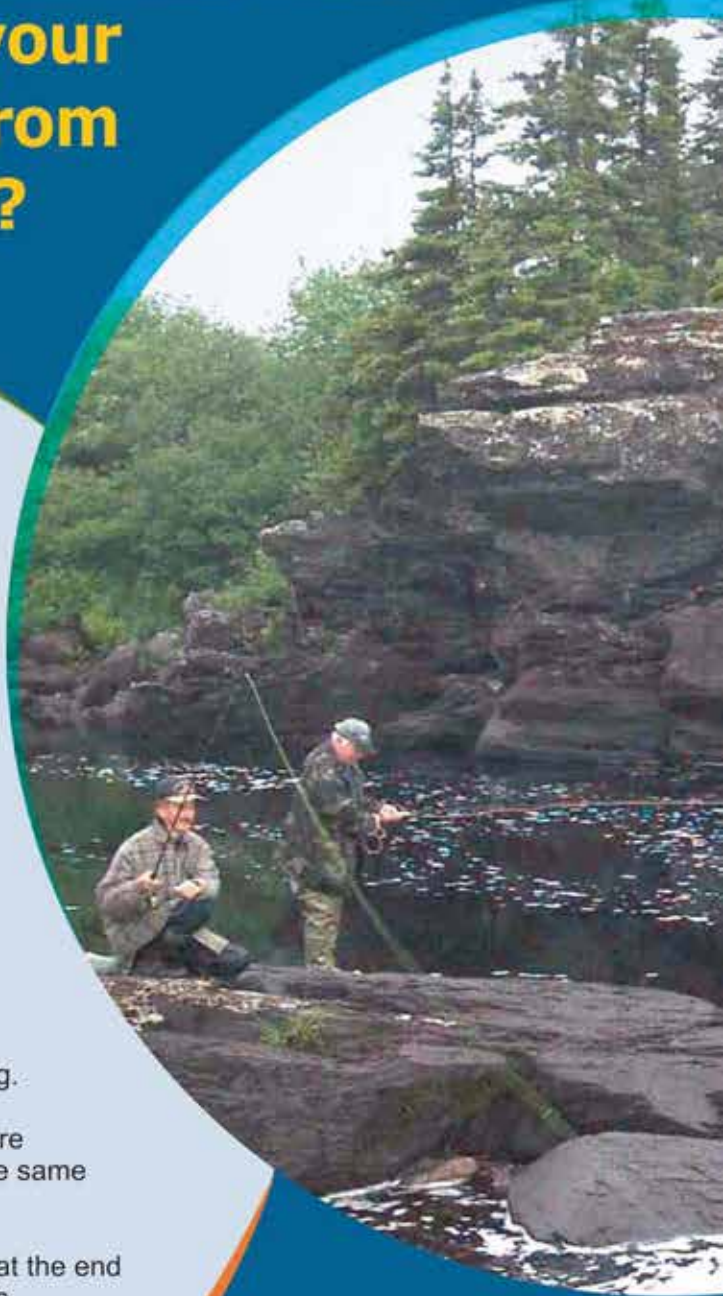




Have you returned your fishing activity log from your salmon licence?

The Salmon Angling Log is DFO's primary source of catch-and-effort information for the recreational salmon fishery, and is an important tool in the stock assessment process. Your support is vital to the success of the project.

- If you purchased a licence and did not fish for the entire season, please return your log indicating this in the box provided.
- If you fished, but did not catch anything, please return your log with your daily fishing activity. When completing your log, if you do not have enough space on the card provided, please record the information on a separate sheet and submit with your card.
- Record the river name and zone. If you do not know the river name or zone, please describe where the river is located. Recording only local pool names can be confusing.
- If you are submitting via our website, and you have more than 10 entries, you can submit additional sheets using the same licence number.
- To ensure accuracy, please record your fishing activity at the end of each day you are fishing, and return your log as soon as possible after the season closes.
- As an incentive to anglers to return their logs, the Salmonid Association of Eastern Newfoundland (SAEN) is, once again, providing \$500.00 in prizes to be drawn in the fall. For more information, contact the SAEN website at www.saen.org or call (709) 722-9300.
